Human trafficking, slavery, and labour exploitation happen all over Australia, in our local communities. The RAP is a project working to build awareness and provide information about human trafficking, via community service announcements (CSAs) on radio.

The project coincides with the announcement of new new Australian laws, enacted on International Women's Day 2013, that criminalise forced marriage, forced labour and organ trafficking.

The RAP aims to reach into local communities, particularly Cultural and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) communities, some of whose members are most at risk of exploitation.
